There is no doubt that the virus has shaken some of the foundations in our lives. Our lives and even Church looks far different than it has before. What does God call followers of Jesus to in times like this? How should we respond to the ongoing COVID-19 pandemic?

Jesus gives those who follow Him a promise of peace that is different from what the world experiences. Jesus encouraged His disciples with these words: "Peace I leave with you; My peace I give to you. Not as the world gives do I give to you. Let not your hearts be troubled, neither let

them be afraid." Jesus promised this followers they didn't have to be afraid. God has promised that nothing can separate us from Him—nothing in all creation can keep us from His love, security, and peace...that includes a virus, and even quarantines. It includes layoffs and economic crises. As Christians, we have a basis for hope that is real and lasting. We can rest in a future that is secure because we have a relationship with God through faith in Jesus.

As the corona virus spreads, so has fear and uncertainty. The world cries out for reassurance and peace. As followers of Jesus in the midst of a pandemic, we have a unique opportunity to demonstrate that the Gospel is not just words but that Jesus makes a difference in how we face hardships. We have the opportunity to live unafraid, to show others a hope that isn't just based on wearing a mask or the development of a vaccine, but that rests in a relationship with the God of the universe. We can be people of peace and love because Jesus has transformed our lives. And as transformed people, we have a message of hope to offer. In an environment of fear and uncertainty, being able to come alongside others (even if it has to be six feet away, or over the phone), and meet their needs with peace and calmness communicates a love that is based on something far greater than our current circumstances. It communicates hope.

In the midst of this uncertainty, reject the temptation to live out of fear. Be at peace. Love others, and share the reason for the hope that you have. We might still feel afraid, but we can believe that God is with us. We may not be in control, but we can trust the One who is. We may not know the future, but we can know the God who does. Set aside your fear, and join us for Worship in Church this Sunday. We look forward to seeing you again!!!
