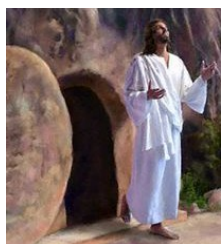


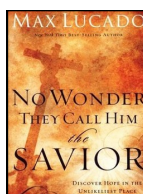
## THANK YOU FOR CELEBRATING EASTER WITH US

- Log in to your account, or go to **"Create An Account"** and follow the prompts.
- Type **New Life Christian Church** in the search bar (marked by the outline of a magnifying glass)
- Remember, **you can't get us on livestream until we are live**, which begins at 9:55 A.M. on Facebook.
