- On your device, go to facebook.com
- Log in to your account, or go to "Create An Account" and follow the prompts.
- Type New Life Christian Church in the search bar (marked by the outline of a magnifying glass)
- Remember, you can't get us on livestream until we are live, which begins at 9:55 A.M. on Facebook.
